Historical background

A destroyed landscape with many fallen, that was the result of the battles in the Huertgen forest.

In the final phase of second world war German troops attempted to stop the Allied invasion into the Rhineland in the rough area between Dueren and Monschau.

At that time Germans and Americans complained many victims of a war that was already lost for some and already won for others. Nothing was decided here, only prolonged and suffered.

The memoration of the victims, the international relationchips or the admonition for peace can be remembered by the walkes on historical tracks more than 77 years after the end of the horrible conflict.


